DRAKE LECTURER*

JAMES W. WAGENER IS PROFESSOR OF EDUCATION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS-SAN ANTONIO. HIS ACADEMIC BACKGROUND INCLUDES BACHELORS DEGREES IN ENGLISH AND IN THEOLOGY FROM SOUTHERN METHODIST UNIVERSITY. FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT AUSTIN HE RECEIVED A MASTERS DEGREE IN ENGLISH AND A PHD IN HISTORY AND PHILOSOPHY OF EDUCATION. WHILE PURSUING THE PHD HE STUDIED WITH WILLIAM E. DRAKE FOR WHOM THIS LECTURE SERIES IS NAMED, ARTHUR MOEHLMAN, JOHN PULLIAM, AND GEORGE I. SANCHEZ.

PROFESSOR WAGENER IS UNIQUELY QUALIFIED TO SPEAK ON THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY AND ADMINISTRATIVE PRACTICE. DURING HIS CAREER IN HIGHER EDUCATION HE HAS SERVED AS ASSISTANT VICE CHANCELLOR FOR ACADEMIC PROGRAMS AND ASSISTANT TO THE CHANCELLOR FOR ACADEMIC AFFAIRS IN THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SYSTEM, ASSISTANT TO THE PRESIDENT AT BOTH THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS-SAN ANTONIO AND THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER-SAN ANTONIO AS WELL AS ACTING DEAN OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER AT SAN ANTONIO DENTAL SCHOOL. FROM 1978 TO 1989 HE SERVED AS PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS-SAN ANTONIO. HE BRINGS A WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE TO HIS REFLECTIONS ON THE INFLUENCE OF PHILOSOPHY OF EDUCATION ON ADMINISTRATIVE PRACTICE.

PROFESSOR WAGENER IS A MEMBER OF THE PHILOSOPHY OF EDUCATION SOCIETY, AMERICAN EDUCATIONAL STUDIES ASSOCIATION, SOCIETY FOR PROFESSORS OF EDUCATION, PHI DELTA KAPPA, SOUTHWEST PHILOSOPHY OF EDUCATION SOCIETY, TEXAS EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATIONS SOCIETY, AND KAPPA DELTA PI. HE HAS SERVED ON COMMITTEES OF THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES, ON THE APPEALS COMMITTEE OF THE SOUTHERN ASSOCIATION OF COLLEGES AND SCHOOLS, THE TEXAS COORDINATING BOARD, THE SOUTH TEXAS HIGHER EDUCATION COUNCIL, AND AS A PEER/REVIEW ADVISOR FOR THE OFFICE OF EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH AND IMPROVEMENT, U.S. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

WITHIN THE COMMUNITY HE HAS SERVED ON THE BOARDS OF THE SAN ANTONIO CHAMBER MUSIC SOCIETY, THE SOUTHWESTERN FOUNDATION FOR BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH, SOUTHWEST RESEARCH INSTITUTE, SAN ANTONIO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, NORTH SAN ANTONIO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, AMERICAN INSTITUTE FOR CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT, ALAMO AREA COUNCIL OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA, WORLD AFFAIRS COUNCIL OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE UNITED WAY.

HE HAS TAUGHT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT AUSTIN, THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE-KNOXVILLE, AND THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS-SAN ANTONIO. HIS WRITINGS HAVE APPEARED IN EDUCATIONAL THEORY, JOURNAL OF THOUGHT, AND EDUCATIONAL STUDIES.

PROFESSOR WAGENER HAS BEEN MARRIED FOR THIRTY YEARS TO DR. ELAINE HOFFMAN WAGENER. THEY HAVE TWO DAUGHTERS. HIS INTERESTS ARE VARIED AS BEFITS A MODERN DAY RENAISSANCE MAN. IN ADDITION TO THOSE ALREADY CITED THEY INCLUDE LISTENING TO GOOD MUSIC, READING GOOD BOOKS, BROWSING IN BOOK STORES, AND ENJOYING HIS GRAND CHILDREN.
