Dr. Doug Davis began his career in education in 1989 teaching social studies at an inner-city high school in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Doug completed the M.Ed. program in Educational Leadership at Louisiana State University in 1995, and his Ph.D. in Education in 1999 under the direction of Spencer Maxcy.
