

Call for Proposals

The Executive Committee of the Society of Philosophy and History of Education (SOPHE) (<http://www.sopheconference.com/>) and the Publisher, Caddo Gap Press (<http://www.caddogap.com/>) invite applications for the editorship of the *Journal of Thought: A Journal of Critical Reflection on Educational Issues*. The quarterly journal has been continuously published since 1966 when it was established by James Van Patten. The *JT* became a collaborative publication between Caddo Gap and SOPHE beginning with its 2007 issues and is an online, blind-and-peer reviewed journal. For more information, see <http://www.journalofthought.com/>. Preference will be given to proposals that are submitted by active members of SOPHE.

In addition to submitting a cover letter and a curriculum vitae, a two-page proposal for the editorship should include the following information:

- Name, position, institutional affiliation and address, and email address of the applicant for the editor's position;
- A brief statement of the applicant's prior experience as an editor, reviewer, and author;
- A statement of institutional support for one's editorship, including information regarding editorial assistance, website maintenance, release time, so forth;
- Identification of associate editors and responsibilities if appropriate;
- A statement of when the new editor would expect to assume her or his duties (e.g., January 1, 2011 or June 1, 2011), and
- Plans for the development of issues (thematic and non-thematic issues).

The current editor and editorial staff will assist the new editorial team during the transition of the *Journal of Thought*. For more information regarding the daily operations of the editor and staff, contact Doug Simpson (doug.simpson@ttu.edu).
